

## SUBMISSION OF FINAL CAMERA-READY PAPER

Authors are requested to check the formatting of the paper prior to final camera-ready submission. A paper will appear in the proceedings:

- If at least one of the authors of the finally accepted paper registers by paying appropriate fees before the registration deadline,
- Submit online the IEEE e-copyright form,
- Upload a camera-ready version of the paper (as per the instructions),
- Fill up the google form, and
- Presents the paper as per the schedule.

IEEE reserves the right to exclude an accepted paper from distribution after the conference, including exclusion from IEEE Xplore, if the submission does not meet IEEE standards for scope and/or quality. Articles excluded from further distribution shall be archived by IEEE but shall not be indexed or appear on IEEE Xplore.

***The final camera-ready paper is due on 25<sup>th</sup> FEB 2025.***

Final Manuscript Instructions

### STEP 1: FINAL PAPER PREPARATION

1. You are requested to revise your manuscript carefully according to the comments of the reviewers and do thorough proofreading of the manuscript to confirm that it will require no revision.
2. Please carefully correct grammatical errors and typos.
3. The paper must be in IEEE **ICDSAAI 2025 Template** format and submitted in both **PDF** and **Word** formats with author's names in order.

4. For final submission, the following criteria must be followed
  - Paper length: Maximum 6 pages including all figures, tables, and references
  - Allowable file size: 5 MB
  - Paper Size: US Letter or A4
  - At this stage, the authors must include their names, affiliations, postal addresses, and email addresses in the paper in proper order.( Author's order will not be changed later)
5. Your final submission should be renamed as **PID.pdf**
6. Page limit: 5-6 pages (including all figures, tables, and references. Under any circumstances cannot exceed the limit of 6 pages)
7. Insert header and footer on the first page of your paper as follows:

You are required to review the similarity report and AI writing report and reduce both for your paper to below 10%. The conference committee will not process your paper if the similarity exceeds 10%.

### STEP 2: IEEE XPLORE COMPATIBILITY OF PDF FILE

The final camera-ready pdf file of your paper must be IEEE Xplore Compatible. You may convert your paper from your source application format to Xplore-compatible PDF by using [IEEE PDF eXpress](#).

In brief, you need to follow the following steps:

1. First-time users should create an [IEEE PDFeXpress®](#) account, entering basic contact information, and getting confirmation of account creation email.
2. Login to IEEE PDFeXpress using the following info:
  - **65575X** for the Conference ID
  - Your registered email address
  - Your password
3. Once you log in:
  - Upload the source file that contains your paper for conversion
  - Receive by email the IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF of your paper
4. Next, you need the camera-ready pdf file that is generated from the IEEE PDF eXpress or passed by the PDF eXpress compliant checking).
5. Please along with the IEEE PDF eXpress compliant pdf file preserve a copy of the compliance message from PDF eXpress which needs to be submitted during your registration. The submitted proof should be renamed as PID\_pdfeXpress.pdf.

### STEP 3: CAMERA READY PDF FILE SUBMISSION

- All submissions must have no password protection on the PDF file, and all fonts must be embedded.
- All submitted papers must be written in English.

### STEP 4: ELECTRONIC IEEE COPYRIGHT FORM (ECF) SUBMISSION

The copyright form will be generated and sent to the corresponding author. A copy of the copyright form must be uploaded as an additional document during the final camera-ready submission. Please rename the file as PID\_copyright.pdf.

Note: ONLY electronic submission of copyright form is allowed and transferring IEEE copyright form electronically is a necessary requirement for publishing your paper in IEEE Xplore.

#### **STEP 5: REGISTRATION**

Please verify the registration details on the conference website and complete the author registration to participate and present your paper at ICDSAAI 2025. Authors must register and pay the registration fee by the deadline, **25<sup>th</sup> FEB 2025**. Use the following link to complete the process.

A scanned copy (PDF) of your payment slip needs to be uploaded by renaming it as PID\_payment slip.pdf

#### **STEP 6: PAPER PRESENTATION**

Authors of registered papers are expected to present during the conference on March 28th & 29th, 2025, and engage with other authors, speakers, and guests throughout the event. The technical program schedule will be updated on the conference website soon.

In addition to the final camera-ready PDF version of your paper, the IEEE ICDSAAI 2025 Committee requires an **author video presentation (MP4 format, with a maximum size of 100 MB)** for the smooth running of the conference sessions. The video can consist of PowerPoint slides with the author's voice narration or a voice-narrated presentation recorded via Zoom or another recording tool.

Authors are kindly requested to upload the video by **25<sup>th</sup> FEB 2025**, as per the instructions from the TPC. This video will be pre-screened by the TPC, and we appreciate your cooperation in finalizing the presentation slides.

On the conference day, authors must be present in their session. A pre-loaded presentation is mandatory for the TPC to address any unforeseen national/global conditions. After the presentation, authors should be ready to answer questions from the Session Chairs and participants.
